## TORREYA DRAGGIN'TAIL

50 KM | PANAMA CITY, FLORIDA  
APRIL 10 | ▲ 1,3

I've been fortunate over the past 20 years or so to have run close to 100 ultras – mostly on trails – in some pretty sweet little locales. Until two years ago however, nary a one had allowed me to sleep in my own bed the night before due to the simple fact that there were no trail ultras within 175 miles of my Florida Panhandle home. And that is amazing, for up here in the what we like to call "the other Florida", there are an abundance of wonderful, deep woods, technical trails, remote state park and national forest lands, as well as other "far off the beaten path" special places that would make great venues for a northwest Florida trail ultra.

In the spring of 2008 that void was filled in spades by veteran Panama City race directors Joe Edgecombe and Marty Kirkland with the advent of the Torreya State Park Draggin' Tail Ultra Trail Challenge 50K.

Torreya State Park is truly a remarkable place. Situated on the banks of the Apalachicola River midway between Tallahassee and Panama City, it is a remote, botanically-rich, ravine-filled mass of creeks and roots and hardwood bottomland that defies belief. It is also a trail runners' dream, but be forewarned: it can be nightmarish! I have tried to describe it while running with non-Floridians here and there and they nod and say, "Yeah, right. You're talking about Florida, aren't you?" Suffice it to say that I'll put Torreya right up there on the difficulty scale with any other 50-km that I have run.

This year's field for the 50-km (and accompanying 25-km) was limited to 40 as a result of the highly environmentally sensitive nature of the trails. As it had in the previous two years, the run filled within days. But unlike the prior two years, runners this time around were greeted with a beautiful dry spring day with temperatures in the 40s and an afternoon high of only 70 or so. Accordingly, the usually sloppy creek crossings and bottomlands and the potentially steamy, exposed, piney woods uplands did not take the toll that they did in 2008 or 2009. Vince Molosky, the only winner that this race has ever known, knocked nearly an hour off of his 2008 time and put up the first-ever sub-five-hour finish time at Torreya. He blasted through the first 25-km in 2:06 and held off a solid performance by Micah Thorning who finished second. Chrissy Coutts was the women's winner, followed by ultra veteran Kirsten Baggett.
